Eligible Discount Fare: Seniors (65 years or older) and passengers with disabilities, who present a Regional Transit Connection Discount Card or a current Disabled Person Placard Identification card issued by the CA Department of Motor Vehicles or a valid transit discount card issued by another California transit agency which is equivalent to the RTCDC, or those who are Medicare cardholders may ride for a discounted fare. The conductor or fare inspector may ask to see a valid ID to verify eligibility or identity. An attendant accompanying a person with a disability also is eligible for this discount when indicated on the RTCDC. Passengers 18 years old and younger qualify for a discount fare. One child four years old or younger may ride free when accompanied by a fare-paying adult. Additional children must travel with Eligible Discount tickets.

HOW TO BUY



Ticket Machine

1. Select Ticket Type
2. Choose Destination Zone
3. Select Number of Tickets
4. Purchase Tickets
5. Insert Cash or Credit Card

Caltrain Mobile is an alternate fare payment method to the ticket machine. Purchase One-way, Day Pass and Zone Upgrade for immediate use only, ticket rules apply. Download the app at the Apple or Google Play stores.

Clipper® card is a reloadable fare payment card that can be used to store Monthly passes and cash value. The card reader at train stations deducts the cost of a ride. One-way trips cost less with Clipper.

Clipper Tips

- Must have at least \$1.25 on card
- Monthly Pass customers only tag on and off for first trip of the month
- Cash value customers must tag on and off for every trip



Caltrain is a **Proof-of-Payment** system. Tickets must be purchased and/or tagged (Clipper) before boarding the train. Tickets must be presented for inspection on request. Passengers who do not have a valid ticket are subject to citation and fine.

REMINDERS

- Remain behind the yellow line on the main platform until the train comes to a complete stop.
- Smoking is not permitted on trains and station property.
- The use of bicycles, skateboards and scooters on platforms and ramps is prohibited.
- Roller blades/skates may not be worn onboard trains or on station property.
- All strollers must be folded/stored on the luggage rack.
- Personal items may be placed under the seat. Please store luggage in the designated areas.
- Keep vestibule, aisles and stairs clear.
- Don't put feet on the seats.
- Open alcoholic containers aren't permitted on trains beginning at 9 p.m. on special event nights.
- Keep cell phone use to a minimum and speak quietly when in use.
- In case of an onboard emergency, the conductor will provide necessary instructions. Please follow instructions for safety reasons.

SERVICE INFORMATION

BABY BULLET EXPRESS SERVICE

Baby Bullet service travels between San Francisco and San Jose in about an hour, stopping at a few popular stations. The red columns on the schedule indicate Baby Bullet trains.

LIMITED-STOP SERVICE

The yellow columns on the weekday timetable indicate: Trains that serve fewer stations than local service. Local trains make all station stops.

TIMED TRANSFERS

Caltrain offers timed transfers during commute-hours in place of local trains. Passengers may choose to ride a Limited-stop train to the designated transfer points. To locate trains with timed transfers, look for the green boxes on the weekday timetable.

WEEKEND SERVICE

Local service and bullet service operates each weekend, serving stations from San Francisco to San Jose. A shuttle bus operates between the San Jose Diridon and Tamien stations. Please note that the service day begins a little later on Sunday and ends earlier.

HOLIDAY SERVICE

Caltrain has alternative schedules on the following holidays: New Year's Day, Presidents Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and the day after, and Christmas Day. ONBOARD AMENITIES

Caltrain offers many onboard amenities for its passengers, such as luggage racks, restrooms, and bicycle storage. The following symbols are noted on the outside of the car offering the amenity:



An area for up to three mobility devices is reserved in the second car from the north end of the train. Please wait at the blue boarding assistance square painted on the ground for assistance.



Dedicated luggage racks are available. Please sit near your luggage.



Bike space is available in the northernmost car and one or two other cars (Bombardier equipment accommodates 72 bikes; gallery trains 80 bikes). Bicyclists must be age 6 or older.

ACCESSIBLE STATIONS

All stations are wheelchair accessible to customers with disabilities except 22nd Street, South San Francisco, Broadway, Atherton and College Park.

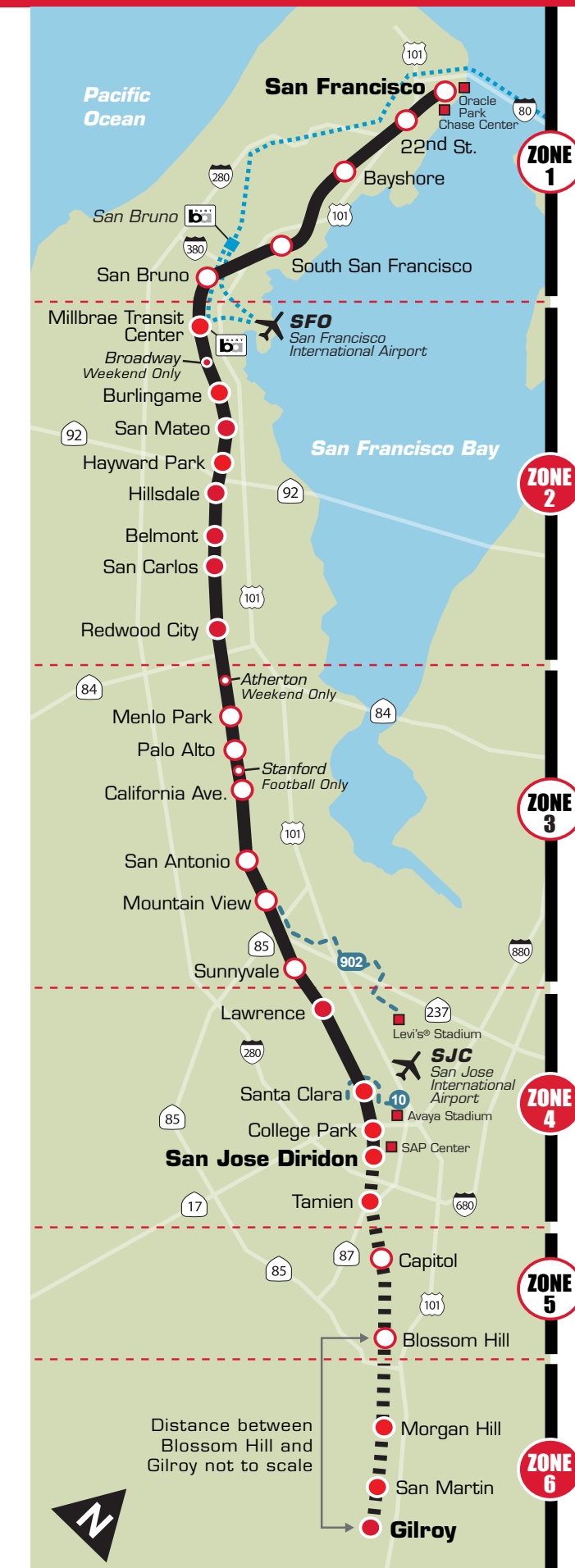
CONSTRUCTION NOTICE
