Caltrain will be hosting a community meeting to present information about the Advanced Signal System Project (also called Communications Based Overlay Signal System Positive Train Control). The advanced signal system will equip the corridor with federally-mandated safety technology and will increase system capacity to help accommodate future ridership demand. The Project will monitor and, if necessary, control train movement in the event of human error. The Advanced Signal System is scheduled to be operational by 2015 and is a key component of the Caltrain Modernization Program, which will electrify the Caltrain Corridor.

To implement this project, there are several installation phases that will occur within the Caltrain right-of-way, usually at night (8pm to 6am) in order to maintain regular train service. Current activities include installing fiber optic cable and the conduit that will encase it. There will also be a base station, similar to the 80 ft. poles already on the right-of-way, installed near the tracks in Sunnyvale.

During the community meeting, you will have an opportunity to learn more about the project and ask questions. The meeting is free and open to the public. We encourage you to attend.
