The corridor is the **#3 most congested area** in the U.S.

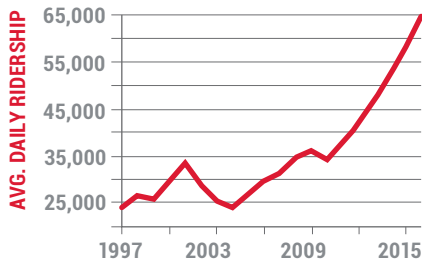


Traffic congestion is **getting worse** and the average delay per person reached **67 hours** per year.

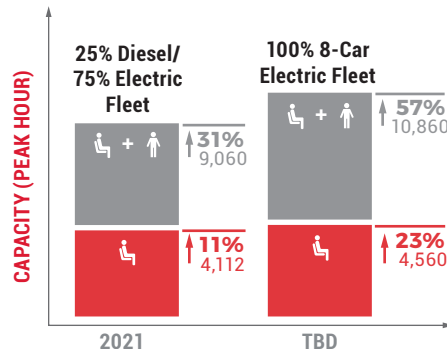

ELECTRIFICATION CAN SOLVE IT

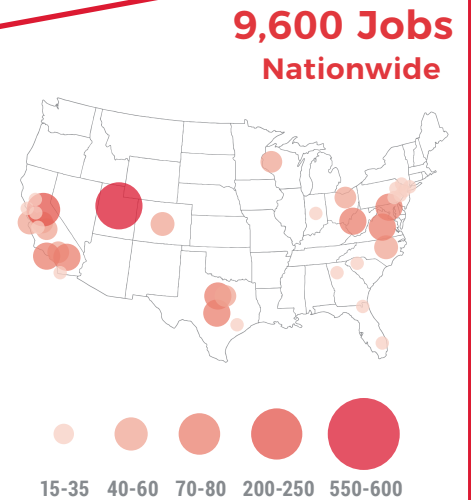
