Chair Peijnenburg asked if the committee could receive a presentation about high-speed rail (HSR). David Olmeda, Director, Maintenance, said there is no information to provide to the committee and at this point the impact on the community is a few years out. Construction plans are still evolving and a contract has yet to be awarded.

Ms. Maguigad said a Request for Proposal (RFP) has been issued for the mainline, but a separate one will be issued for the corridor south of the Diridon Station.

Mike Riepe asked about the status of the communications-based overlay signal system. Ms. Maguigad said testing has begun along the corridor.

Chair Peijnenburg said the neighborhoods receive weekly construction notices and it states grinding is being done, but he never hears anything and asked if anything is being done. Ms. Maguigad said yes grinding is being done, but since the notices go out to neighborhoods along the corridor the grinding may be north of CEMOF and not apply to the CEMOF neighborhoods.
