


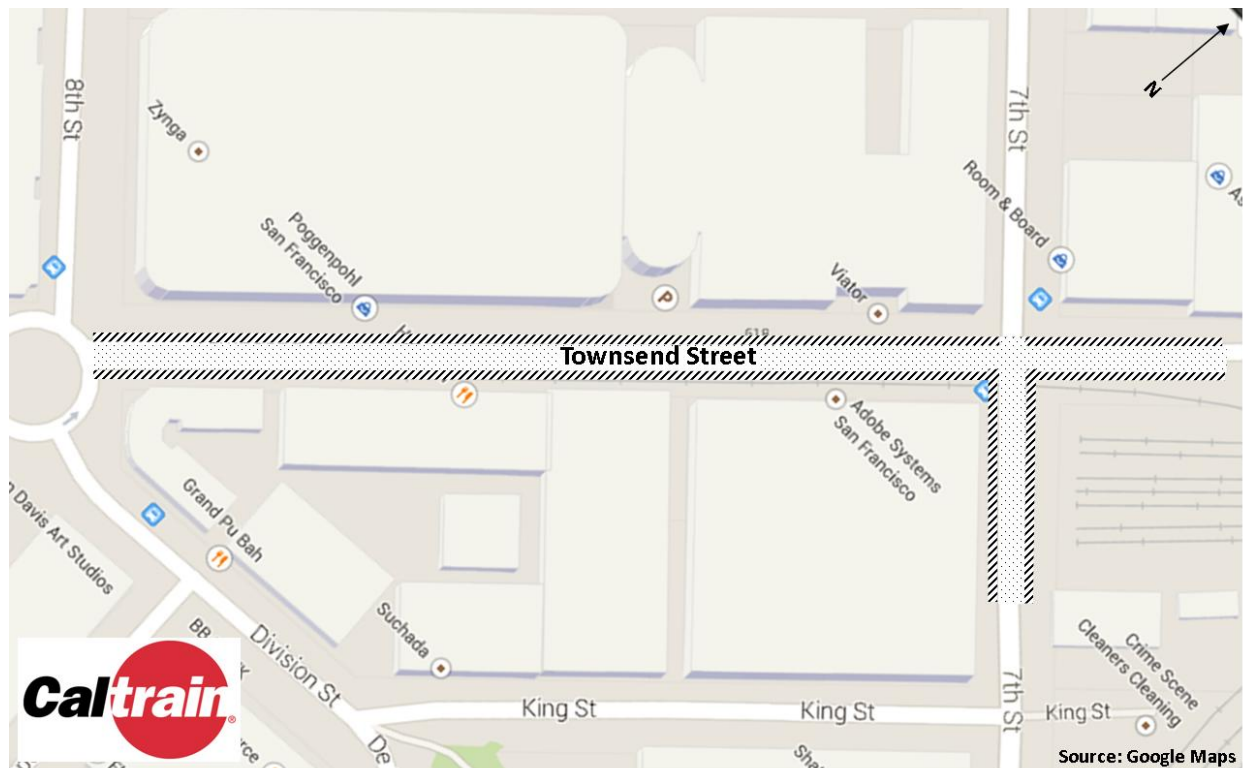


San Francisco Yard Track Reconfiguration Project

Dear Caltrain Neighbor:

Starting Sept. 30, 2013 Caltrain will begin to remove railroad track and perform street resurfacing on Townsend Street between Sixth and Eighth streets. Track removal will improve conditions for bicyclists and pedestrians traveling along Townsend Street. Construction activities will require temporary reduction of street lane, bicycle lane and parking access in both directions along Townsend Street between Sixth and Eighth streets and along Seventh Street between King and Townsend. Construction is expected to last four weeks.

-  Parking and bicycle lane access along Townsend Street between Seventh and Eighth streets will be restricted from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
-  Parking and bicycle lane access along Seventh Street between King and Townsend streets will be restricted from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
-  Cyclists will have full access to the vehicular lanes in the project area.
- Pedestrian access will not be restricted in the project area.
