## **25th Avenue Grade Separation Project**


**Fiber Optic Cable Relocation** 

Dear Caltrain Neighbor,

As part of the 25th Avenue Grade Separation Project that will improve safety for motorists and pedestrians, crews will be relocating fiber optic cable. In an effort to minimize traffic impacts, the construction operation will be located in the Caltrain temporary parking lot between Curiosity Way and 31st Avenue. Mobilization and pre-construction activities have begun with the main construction activities starting in early October.

Construction hours will be Monday through Saturday from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Boring equipment will be onsite and construction activities will include directional drilling and the use of water/vacuum trucks to move excess water from the bore pit. Due to the nature of this work, parking spaces #1 to #30 and #140 to #144 will be temporarily unavailable. Cars will be able to drive through this section of the parking lot via one way traffic control with flaggers. Vehicles can continue to access the temporary lot at 28th Avenue. Thank you for your patience during this important safety improvement project.

The 25th Avenue Grade Separation Project will raise the tracks and slightly lower the road (grade separate) at E. 25th Avenue in San Mateo. Caltrain, in cooperation with the City of San Mateo, is implementing the project to improve safety for both motorists and pedestrians, and to reduce traffic congestion and horn noise. In addition, the project will complete east-west street connections at 28th and 31st Avenues and build a new elevated Hillsdale Station with updated amenities at E. 28th Avenue.
