

25th Avenue Grade Separation Project Leslie Street: Lane Closure & Parking Restriction for Paving

Dear Caltrain Neighbor,

As San Mateo's 25th Avenue Grade Separation Project progresses toward its goals to improve safety, and reduce traffic congestion and train horn noise, there will be a temporary impact with the paving of Leslie Street (near CA-92).

The paving will occur on Saturday, June 13, 2020, from 7:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. The southbound lane of Leslie Street will remain open to through traffic. When the paving is complete, Leslie Street will return to the existing condition with one through lane and temporary parking restrictions. Please note unintended schedule changes do occur, and we thank you in advance for your patience.
