

25th Avenue Grade Separation Project Removal of Temporary Shoring at E. 28th and E. 31st Avenues

UPDATE: The work described below will now start as early as June 16, 2020.

Dear Caltrain Neighbor,

As San Mateo's 25th Avenue Grade Separation Project progresses towards its goals to improve safety, and reduce traffic congestion and train horn noise, there will be an upcoming construction impact. Starting on June 16, 2020, crews will begin removing the temporary support structures (shoring) that were built for construction at E. 28th and E. 31st Avenues near the railroad tracks.

The construction hours will be 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., and noise levels will vary during construction hours. Activities will begin with crews removing track, ties, and then shoring. This work is anticipated to take approximately two to three weeks. Please note unintended schedule changes do occur, and we thank you in advance for your patience.
