

## 25th Avenue Grade Separation Project Notification

## Partial Lane/Sidewalk Closures on E. 25th Avenue

Dear Caltrain Neighbor,

Partial sidewalk and lane closures on E. 25th Avenue between El Camino Real and S. Delaware will continue as part of the 25th Avenue Grade Separation Project and will be intermittent for up to four months.

At night on Friday, February 2 and Saturday, February 3, and the continuing on Monday, February 5 for approximately two weeks, there will be one lane open to traffic on 25th Avenue between El Camino Real and S. Delaware from 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. Flaggers will be assisting with traffic control. During the day from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., there will be one lane in each direction open to traffic. Some street parking will be unavailable due to construction both day and night during this time and there will be partial sidewalk closures.

Construction includes installing cast-in-drilled-hole piles within the Caltrain right-of-way and signal work. Caltrain will establish signs for pedestrians and motorists to help with traffic flow. **All businesses along E. 25th Avenue will remain open during construction.** Residents may experience increased noise levels and traffic conditions in the neighborhood due to the construction activity. We apologize for the inconvenience.

Caltrain, in cooperation with the City of San Mateo, is raising the tracks and slightly lower the road (grade separate) at E. 25th Avenue in San Mateo. This will improve safety for both motorists and pedestrians, and will reduce local traffic congestion and horn noise in San Mateo. In addition, the project will provide an opportunity to complete east-west street connections at 28th and 31st Avenues. As part of the project improvements, Caltrain will build a new elevated Hillsdale Station located at E. 28th Avenue. The new station will offer updated amenities and will allow for better safety and reduced traffic.
