

# More Parking Available for Caltrain Riders

As congestion worsens and gas prices increase, commuters are looking to Caltrain to get them where they want to go. And, with express service, San Jose has become a popular boarding station. However, parking spaces have been disappearing with the increased popularity.

To provide an option, Caltrain has developed a program with the city's Redevelopment Agency to allow commuters to park in two lots near the Caltrain station (see map on back). The first lot, located at San Fernando and Montgomery streets, offers daily parking for \$3 (via pay-by-space). The second lot is located at 150 S. Montgomery St. and is available to those who purchase a \$25 monthly parking permit from Standard Parking at its downtown office (104 Park Center Plaza, suite A). Caltrain monthly parking permits are not valid in either parking lot. Standard Parking may cite or tow cars not displaying one of its permits or not being in a paid space. Valley Transportation Authority also offers ways to get to the train station via shuttles, buses and light rail. VTA allows customers presenting a two-zone or greater Caltrain Monthly Pass to receive a local fare credit on its bus and light rail services.
