



San Mateo Replacement Parking Track – Neighborhood Enhancements Online Survey #2 & Open House (April 28, 2020) Cancelled

Thank you for your continued interest in the replacement San Mateo Parking Track that was removed to facilitate the construction of the 25th Avenue Grade Separation Project, which will improve safety and traffic flow, reduce horn noise, and result in a new Hillsdale Station.

Please note that due to COVID-19 and the County’s Shelter in Place order, both originally planned Open Houses—including the April 28, 2020 Open House—are cancelled. The project is committed to continue to collect feedback and communicate with the neighborhood as this process moves forward (more details below). Thank you for your patience during these unprecedented times.

Just to recap, a Hayward Park survey was distributed in March 2020 to help identify neighborhood-preferred enhancements for the San Mateo Parking Track. While a block wall with vegetation was the clear neighborhood priority, the type of vegetation (ivy versus creeping fig) was too close to call. [Results](#) are posted online under “resources.”
