In March 2020, a Hayward Park survey helped identify neighborhood-preferred enhancements for the San Mateo Parking Track (results posted here). While a block wall with vegetation was the clear neighborhood priority, the type of vegetation was too close to call (42.1% preferred creeping fig and 39.5% preferred ivy). Renderings were created to help those who live and work in Hayward Park visualize the two options.
