



San Mateo Replacement Parking Track – Neighborhood Enhancements Survey #2 Results

Thank you for your continued interest in the replacement San Mateo Parking Track that was removed to facilitate the construction of the 25th Avenue Grade Separation Project, which will improve safety and traffic flow, reduce horn noise, and result in a new Hillsdale Station.

SURVEY RESULTS

Thank you to everyone who took the time to take the online surveys. **Your feedback helped make the final determination for the neighborhood enhancement—a block wall with creeping fig.** Over ~80% of the Survey #2 respondents selected this type of vegetation, making it the clear choice. The results of both surveys are posted to the [webpage](#) in the “resources” section.

NEXT STEPS

Over the next few weeks a draft design will be created of the neighborhood enhancement which will be shared online, along with an opportunity for additional feedback. The neighborhood will be notified of the draft design through a mailer, the distribution list, and social media such as NextDoor. The final design will then be developed and posted to the webpage and shared via the distribution list.
