
February 2006 Caltrain Annual Passenger Counts

The annual Caltrain passenger counts were conducted in February 2006 as has been done every year for the last decade and less consistently before that back to 1992. The February 2006 count follows the methodology of the annual counts of previous years. Comparisons to one year ago (February 2005) should be considered in the light of the "Re-Invention" of Caltrain service in August 2005, when Baby Bullet service was increased and pure Local trains were discontinued in the peak. This re-invention came just over one year after the June 2004 initial implementation of Baby Bullet service that radically changed peak-hour service on Caltrain. This is the second year of weekend counts, after two years (February 2004 and 2003) of discontinued weekend service during the CTX construction project.

Overall Ridership

Weekday Ridership

Caltrain average weekday ridership (AWR) has increased almost 13 percent as compared to February 2005, with a total of 32,031 average weekday boardings. The passenger count trend since 1992 is shown in the graph below. Since 1992 Caltrain AWR has increased by more than



50 percent. Caltrain hit its peak ridership in 2001 and was in a steady down-hill decline until the implementation of Baby Bullet service. The downturn in the economy was the main impetus for loss of riders. However other factors also may have exacerbated the ridership decline, including service reductions and fare adjustments that took place over the years of that decline. Since the implementation of the Baby Bullet schedule, the ridership trend has been reversed. With the introduction of more and faster trains in August 2005, the upward trend has continued.

When ranked by average weekday boardings, the top 10 stations remained constant for both 2005 and 2006, with some shifting of the order. There were some major increases in absolute numbers and percent changes of total boardings, however the top four stations remained in the same order and all 10 had significant (more than 10 percent) increases in boardings. The results are as follows:

Of the five stations to begin Baby Bullet in August 2005, Sunnyvale, Redwood City and Tamien saw ridership increases of more than 30 percent with the other two (San Mateo and Menlo Park) showing increases of approximately 16 percent. San Francisco and 22nd Street which received additional Baby Bullet trains in August 2005, both saw particularly impressive ridership gains. The 22nd Street Station increased by a staggering 46.3 percent, while San Francisco gained 1,245 passengers for a 21.1 percent increase.

The regular (excluding special events) stations that showed the most overall change since February 2005 are as follows:

With the re-invention of Caltrain service in August 2005, weekday service to Atherton, Broadway and Paul Avenue was suspended. Peak hour shuttles provide a connection for passengers from Atherton to Redwood City and from Broadway to Millbrae.

Train Capacity

The February 2006 counts show that the traditional (northbound morning and southbound afternoon) peak trains and Baby Bullets continue to have the highest peak loads. The highest maximum loads have decreased from the high 90s percent of capacity to approximately 80 percent of capacity. Since Caltrain has increased capacity by introducing additional trains in the peak and there are now additional Baby Bullet and other fast train options, the most popular trains are not on the verge of being over capacity. The 2005 count showed the top three trains at 99, 97 and 94 percent of capacity. The following table shows the five trains with the highest maximum loads in each direction.

This indicates the passengers' preference for shorter travel times and that passengers are spreading themselves among the greater number of express options. The low passenger loads for local trains is largely due to the fact that there are no local trains in the peak of the peak. The next table further breaks the limited trains into ones with distinct local and express halves (labeled Express/Local) verses ones that skip stations throughout their trip (labeled Uniform Limited).

Commute Patterns

The traditional peak direction (northbound morning and southbound evening) and the reverse peak (southbound morning and northbound evening) commute markets both showed significant gains from February 2005 to February 2006. However, the reverse peak is showing a significantly higher rate of growth. This may be partially caused by the larger increase in service for the reverse peak compared with the traditional peak. With the Caltrain re-invented schedule, for the first time, the number of trains in the traditional peak is equal to the reverse peak service. The ratio of those traveling north in the morning to those traveling south in the morning continues to remain at approximately 60/40, but the reverse gained this past year, a turnaround from the trend from 2004 to 2005. In February 2005, 61.1 percent of the commute (peak) passengers traveled in the traditional direction; this decreased to 59.6 percent in February 2005. The reverse direction increased from 38.8 percent to 40.4 percent.

Ridership on the commute/peak only Gilroy extension has shown continued decline. There was an error in last year's figures for the Gilroy extension. The correct total boardings should have been 636, which made for a total decrease of 31 passengers or 4.6 percent lower compared to 2004. The February 2006 boardings were 471. This is a decrease of 25.9 percent and is partially the result of the reduction of the number of Gilroy trips from eight in February 2005 to six in February 2006. Since February 2004, Gilroy ridership has decreased by 196 daily passengers, a loss of 29 percent. Some of the decrease in Gilroy is due to major improvements to Highway 101 between San Jose and Gilroy.

Bicycles

The February 2006 count showed 2,271 bike boardings. This is a 22 percent increase from the February 2005 number of 1,860. The top five stations and trains by bicycle usage are listed below:

Weekend

Weekend service resumed in June 2004, with the implementation of the original Baby Bullet schedule, after a two-year hiatus to accommodate construction. During that time, limited substitution bus service was provided to five stations. Saturday train service was restored to the level it was before the suspension of service. Sunday service was increased 50 percent to provide hourly service. As part of the Caltrain Re-invented service changes in August 2005, weekend service was adjusted. The first trains on Saturday and Sunday in both the northbound and southbound directions were eliminated, resulting in weekend service starting one hour later. Saturday 9 P.M. departures were added at San Francisco and San Jose Diridon to provide more uniform service. Service between Tamien station and San Jose Diridon station continues to be provided by a shuttle on weekends.

Weekend ridership has significantly increase from last year. The Sunday increase of 41.1 percent is particularly impressive and bringing Sunday ridership much closer to Saturday's.

Ridership on Saturdays is below the 2002 levels, with a 16.2 percent decline. Sunday ridership has surpassed 2002 levels, with a 17.7 percent increase. Overall weekend ridership is slightly lower than before the two year weekend shut-down. Weekend numbers are summarized in the following chart from 2002 and 2006:




