Storm Drain Installation


Dear Caltrain Neighbor,

As part of the 25th Avenue Grade Separation Project that will improve safety for motorists and pedestrians, crews will install a new storm drain on Delaware from 31st Avenue to Pacific Boulevard. Construction activities include removing the sidewalk, excavating, installing the storm drain pipe and drainage inlets, and making a handful of connections to the existing manholes located on Delaware. Partial sidewalk and lane closures, as well as parking restrictions, will occur in this area of work.

Storm drain construction is estimated to begin in early July and last for one month, with work hours during the day from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Saturday. Please note the construction schedule is subject to change. We apologize for any inconvenience this work may cause.

The 25th Avenue Grade Separation Project will raise the tracks and slightly lower the road (grade separate) at E. 25th Avenue in San Mateo. Caltrain, in cooperation with the City of San Mateo, is implementing the project to improve safety for both motorists and pedestrians, and to reduce traffic congestion and horn noise. In addition, the project will complete east-west street connections at 28th and 31st Avenues and build a new elevated Hillsdale Station with updated amenities at E. 28th Avenue.
