Project Overview



25th Ave Grade Sep Project Benefits

Overall Project Benefits

- Pedestrian, cyclist, and motorist safety
- Safe rail operations and fewer system-wide delays
- Improved traffic flow and enhanced east-west connectivity
- Reduced train horn noise

New Station Benefits

- Centerboard platform: Convenient access to both north and southbound trains
- Additional and improved shelters
- New landscaping, mosaic wall, aesthetics inspired by Bay Meadows

Hillsdale Station Closure Part of Larger Project

Closure Begins: May 16, 2020

- Duration: Up to 6 months
- Closure Needed
 - Transition ground-level tracks to elevated tracks
 - Create east-west connection at 28th Avenue
 - Build new Hillsdale Station (closer to 28th Avenue)
- Caltrain will continue overall passenger service for its daily commuters during the closure

Development of Rider Closure Plan



Process: Plan Development

- Analyzed Survey Data and Annual Counts
- Reviewed train timetables and bus / shuttle frequency
- Analyzed rider bus / shuttle needs and capacity
- Reviewed public feedback
- Focused on rider experience during the closure
- Acknowledged challenges




Hillsdale Station Survey: Distribution

- Survey link distribution at Hillsdale Station
 - July 24, 2019, between 5:00 a.m. and 3:45 p.m.
 - 14 surveyors
 - Approx. 2,898 links distributed
- Closed July 31
- 1,006 responses (967 partial)
 - Represents 31% of daily riders based on annual count




Survey: Continue to Ride Caltrain vs Alternate Travel Mode

Majority of riders likely to continue riding Caltrain during closure*



For the 12% unlikely to ride Caltrain during closure, most will drive instead**

Survey Comments

"Hopefully, Caltrain will provide the good services during Hillsdale Station closure period and the construction will be completed in time as expected."


"Add more trains to stop at Belmont, aside from the ones that would normally stop at Hillsdale, to give people more options."

Survey: Preferred Alternative Station


Belmont is preferred station during closure

Proximity is primary reason for selecting preferred station






Projected Bus & Shuttle Ridership (AM)

- Projected Ridership using Survey Results & 2019 Annual Count
 - AM Peak: start of service to 9:00 a.m. (approximately 4 hours)
 - Currently walking to/from Hillsdale Station, Using Belmont during closure
- SB Boarding at Hillsdale → Belmont
 - Total AM Peak Riders using bus 144, Max. up to 33 riders per bus
 - Total AM Peak Riders using shuttle 117, Max. up to 19 riders per shuttle
- NB Alighting at Belmont → Hillsdale
 - Total AM Peak Riders using bus 108, Max. up to 26 riders per bus
 - Total AM Peak Riders using shuttle 88, Max. up to 14 riders per shuttle





Public Feedback

- Over 4,000 touchpoints, ~2,050 provided feedback
- Sources: Council Meetings, City Staff, neighborhood associations, office tenants, Nueva School, project email, 20+ public meetings, virtual town hall

Themes:

- Shuttles: Frequent free service, stop inside Bay Meadows
- Bus: Free between San Mateo and Belmont Stations (ECR & 292)
- Parking: Free Belmont Station parking
- Bikes: Improved bike facilities between Hillsdale and Belmont Station
- Pedestrian access concern from Bay Meadows to ECR bus stops
- Traffic impact to Ralston/ECR intersection and increased TNC use
- Go Pass concession to members whose primary station is Hillsdale



Challenges (Rider)

- COVID-19 impacts to bus, shuttle, and train service
- 2019 Shuttle & SamTrans Bus Driver Shortage
 - Shuttles Increase in Did Not Operate (DNO) Trips since FY2018 Q3 (started Oct 2017)
 - SamTrans Increase in Did Not Operate (DNO) Trips since Aug 2019
 - SamTrans Mitigation: Suspend ECR Rapid (Effective 1/19/2020)
- Hillsdale Station Triangle Parking Lot Closure (Eff 1/27/20)
 - Developer Terminated Lease
 - Permanent closure of the triangle lot at the Hillsdale station
 - Result: Loss of parking and shuttle service was redirected to Pacific Blvd.
- Limited Funding for shuttles (Project and Public)


RIDER CLOSURE PLAN

All plans are subject to change based on COVID-19 service changes and funding

- All Hillsdale Caltrain service switches to Belmont
- Free parking at Belmont Station
- Free SamTrans ECR bus service between Belmont and San Mateo Stations
- Free SamTrans Route <u>292</u> bus service between Hillsdale Shopping Center and San Mateo
 Station
- Free SamTrans bus service on all routes (except FCX) for riders with the Caltrain Clipper monthly pass 2+ zones
- Free peak period Belmont/Hillsdale Shuttle service (if available)
- Caltrain will coordinate with existing public and private shuttles serving the two stations

Belmont Station Parking

- FREE Starting May 16, 2020
- Parking at Belmont Station: 389 spaces (7% utilized as of 3/4/20, 11% utilized as 4/16/19)
- Capacity comparable to current Hillsdale Station parking
- 29 stalls in north parking lot to be used for shuttle pick-up/drop-off







North of Station

SamTrans Bus Services

- Free SamTrans Route <u>ECR</u> rides on all northbound and southbound stops between San Mateo and Belmont Stations
- Free SamTrans Route <u>292</u> rides between Hillsdale Shopping Center and San Mateo Station
- Do not need proof of train fare Rides are free!
- Caltrain customers with a 2-Zone Monthly Pass can ride SamTrans free
- Free 2-hour transfers on other routes with Clipper and SamTrans Mobile App

Belmont Station: Bus & Shuttle Map






Belmont Station: Shuttle Map (Detailed)






Hillsdale Station: Bus & Shuttle Map






Bay Meadows: Bus & Shuttle Map
