


28TH AVENUE: NIGHTIME ROAD CLOSURE Between S. Delaware Street & El Camino Real

Dear Caltrain Neighbor,

As San Mateo's 25th Avenue Grade Separation Project progresses toward its goals to improve safety, and reduce traffic congestion and train horn noise, there is an upcoming construction impact we wish to make you aware of:

Road Closure on 28 Avenue – March 25, 2021

On March 25, 2021, crews will erect a sign on the overpass bridge on 28th Avenue. The road in this location between S. Delaware Street and El Camino Real will be closed at night from 8:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. A detour with signage will be available. Construction activities include a crane and installation of the sign.



Please note unintended schedule changes do occur, and we thank you in advance for your patience. These activities will bring the project one step closer to creating the long-awaited east-west connections for pedestrians, cyclists, and vehicles in San Mateo.

About the 25th Avenue Grade Separation Project

Caltrain, in cooperation with the City of San Mateo, is improving safety, traffic flow, and reducing train horn noise in the City. The project will separate the railroad tracks from the road at E. 25th Avenue, create two new east-west connections at 28th and 31st Avenues, and build a new Hillsdale Station with updated amenities to better serve the community.
