

25th Avenue Grade Separation Project UPCOMING S. DELAWARE ST. & 28TH AVE. LANE CLOSURES

Dear Caltrain Neighbor,

As San Mateo's 25th Avenue Grade Separation Project progresses toward its goals to improve safety, and reduce traffic congestion and train horn noise, there will be traffic pattern changes due to construction we wish to make you aware of:

S. DELAWARE ST. & 28TH AVENUE LANE CLOSURES

On July 29 and July 30, from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m there will be intermittent lane closures on S. Delaware Street and 28th Avenue. During the lane closures, traffic flow in both directions will be maintained at all times. There will be cones, signs, arrow boards, and other traffic control devices installed to help safely navigate around the closures.



Please note unintended schedule changes do occur, and we thank you in advance for your patience. These activities will help bring the project one-step closer to creating the long-awaited east-west connections for pedestrians, cyclists, and vehicles in San Mateo.
