


## 25th Avenue Grade Separation Project UPCOMING NIGHT EL CAMINO REAL LANE CLOSURES

Dear Caltrain Neighbor,

As San Mateo's 25th Avenue Grade Separation Project progresses toward its goals to improve safety, and reduce traffic congestion and train horn noise, there will be traffic pattern changes due to construction we wish to make you aware of:

## EL CAMINO REAL LANE CLOSURES (between 26th and 31st Avenue)

On July 13 and July 14, from 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m., there will be intermittent lane closures on El Camino Real between 25th and 31st Avenues. The closures will be both northbound and southbound. There will also be intermittent lane closures on 31st Avenue at El Camino Real. During the closures, at least one lane will be open in each direction at all times. There will be cones, signs, arrow boards, and other traffic control devices installed to help safely navigate around the closures.



Please note unintended schedule changes do occur, and we thank you in advance for your patience. These activities will help bring the project one-step closer to creating the long-awaited east-west connections for pedestrians, cyclists, and vehicles in San Mateo.

The project will separate the railroad tracks from the road at E. 25th Avenue, create two new east-west connections at 28th and 31st Avenues, and build a new Hillsdale Station with updated amenities to better serve the community.
