

## Caltrain Hillsdale Pedestrian Bridge Closure & Temporary Hillsdale Blvd. Nighttime Lane Closures

Dear Caltrain Neighbor,

As San Mateo's 25th Avenue Grade Separation Project progresses towards its goals to improve safety, and reduce traffic congestion and train horn noise, there will be some upcoming impacts as Caltrain works to strengthen the Hillsdale train bridge with a steel girder and prepare for the new track alignment. Thank you for your patience while the following occurs:

- Starting as early as Wednesday, March 25, 2020, the Caltrain Hillsdale pedestrian
  bridge located to the west of the tracks will be closed. Pedestrians who typically
  use the Caltrain pedestrian bridge/walkway to cross Hillsdale Boulevard are
  encouraged to allow extra time for their arrival at Hillsdale Station. Please see
  map (on back) for an alternative pedestrian route during this temporary closure.
- Starting as early as March 30, 2020, there will be weeknight work for approximately 1-2weeks on the Hillsdale train bridge from 8:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. During this time, Hillsdale Boulevard lanes will be intermittently closed, with bidirectional traffic flow at times and detours.
