


E. 25TH AVENUE: UPCOMING LANES/ROAD CLOSURE Between S. Delaware Street & Palm Avenue

Dear Caltrain Neighbor,

As San Mateo's 25th Avenue Grade Separation Project progresses toward its goals to improve safety, and reduce traffic congestion and train horn noise, there is an upcoming construction impact we wish to make you aware of:

Lane Closures on E. 25th Avenue – Beginning March 1, 2021

Starting March 1, 2021, crews will begin to lower a portion of the road on E. 25th Avenue between S. Delaware Street and Palm Avenue. Eastbound lanes in this location will be closed 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Only one westbound lane will remain open. Drivers are encouraged to use the new east-west connection at 28th Avenue during this time. Access to businesses on E. 25th Avenue will be maintained.



Road Closure on E. 25th Avenue – Starting Late March/Early April 2021

Phase II to lower the road on E. 25th Avenue between S. Delaware Street and Palm Avenue is anticipated to begin late March/early April 2021. All lanes in this location will be closed to 24 hours a day, seven days a week for approximately four months. Drivers are encouraged to use the new eastwest connection at 28th Avenue during this time. Access to businesses on E. 25th Avenue will be maintained.

Construction Information

Work hours will be from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday to Saturday. Construction activities include demolition, excavation, drainage work, the building of retaining walls and new sidewalks, electrical work, and paving. Please note unintended schedule changes do occur, and we thank you in advance for your patience. These activities will bring the project one step closer to creating the long-awaited eastwest connections for pedestrians, cyclists, and vehicles in San Mateo.
