## 25th Avenue Grade Separation Project


## Dear Caltrain Neighbor,

Thank you for your patience as work on the 25th Avenue Grade Separation Project that will improve safety for motorists and pedestrians continues. AT&T utility relocation work for the project began in late January with mobilization of the construction equipment and boring.


Starting in mid-April, sheet pile installation will begin. Sheet piles are put into the ground to act as a retention system to support excavation, and this specific activity will be at two different locations for approximately three days each. Work hours will be from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday through Saturday. Neighbors may experience noise during these times. Please note, the schedule is subject to change and we apologize for any inconvenience this may cause.

The 25th Avenue Grade Separation Project will raise the tracks and slightly lower the road (grade separate) at E. 25th Avenue in San Mateo. Caltrain, in cooperation with the City of San Mateo, is implementing the project to improve safety for both motorists and pedestrians, and to reduce traffic congestion and horn noise. In addition, the project will complete east-west street connections at 28th and 31st Avenues and build a new elevated Hillsdale Station with updated amenities at E. 28th Avenue.
