

Dear Caltrain Neighbor,

Thank you for your patience as work on the 25th Avenue Grade Separation Project that will improve safety for motorists and pedestrians continues. AT&T utility relocation work for the project began in late January with mobilization of the construction equipment, boring, and sheet piling. **As early as June 26, an underground utility vault will be installed at the two locations where work has been occurring** (see map below). The work is anticipated to take three weeks and work hours will be 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday through Saturday. This necessary stage of the project will involve a crane (expect back-up alarms). Please note unintended schedule changes do occur, and we thank you in advance for your patience.

About the 25th Avenue Grade Separation Project

Caltrain, in cooperation with the City of San Mateo, is improving safety, traffic flow, and reducing train horn noise in the City. The Project is focused on improving traffic flow on three roads: 1) On 25th Avenue, the Project will raise the tracks and slightly lower the road at E. 25th Avenue & S. Delaware to separate the trains and tracks from the street and sidewalk; 2) On E. 28th Avenue, the Project will create a new east-west through street; and 3) On E. 31st Avenue, the Project will create a new east-west through street. The Project is also installing a new elevated Hillsdale Station with updated amenities.
