25th Avenue Grade Separation Project

Road Closure: Pacific Blvd. at Hillsdale Ave.

Dear Caltrain Neighbor,

As part of the 25th Avenue Grade Separation Project that will improve safety for motorists and pedestrians, Pacific Blvd., from S. Delaware to the Hillsdale Blvd. on-ramp, will be closed 24 hours, 7 days a week starting October 2 until late October (see map below). During this time:

- Pedestrian access will be maintained.
- Vehicles will be routed to Saratoga via Hillsdale Blvd.
- For vehicles heading north on Pacific Blvd., access to the Hillsdale Blvd. on-ramp will be maintained.
- For Caltrain customers, vehicles can access the permanent parking lot by heading south on S. Delaware from Franklin Parkway/31st Avenue.

Construction hours will be 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday through Saturday, but the closure will be maintained 24/7. During this time crews will do trench work, install pipes, backfill, and pave. Please note the construction schedule is subject to change and we apologize for any inconvenience this work may cause.

The 25th Avenue Grade Separation Project will raise the tracks and slightly lower the road (grade separate) at E. 25th Avenue in San Mateo. Caltrain, in cooperation with the City of San Mateo, is implementing the project to improve safety for both motorists and pedestrians, and to reduce traffic congestion and horn noise. In addition, the project will complete east-west street connections at 28th and 31st Avenues and build a new elevated Hillsdale Station with updated amenities at E. 28th Avenue.
