
Fiber Optic Cable Relocation

Dear Caltrain Neighbor,


As part of the 25th Avenue Grade Separation Project that will improve safety for motorists and pedestrians, crews will relocate fiber optic cable starting at Pacific Boulevard and Concar Drive, going underneath State Route 92, and ending just south of Borel Creek. Construction is anticipated to start on Monday, June 25. Due to the nature of this work, Pacific Boulevard between Concar Drive and 19th Avenue will be closed to vehicles for approximately two months. Pedestrian access will be maintained during the closure. Please note the construction schedule is subject to change and we apologize for any inconvenience this work may cause.

The 25th Avenue Grade Separation Project will raise the tracks and slightly lower the road (grade separate) at E. 25th Avenue in San Mateo. Caltrain, in cooperation with the City of San Mateo, is implementing the project to improve safety for both motorists and pedestrians, and to reduce traffic congestion and horn noise. In addition, the project will complete east-west street connections at 28th and 31st Avenues and build a new elevated Hillsdale Station with updated amenities at E. 28th Avenue.
