### **Overview**

- The COVID-19 pandemic continues to significantly affect Caltrain's operations and the communities we serve
- Delta variant of COVID-19 has led to a steep rise in the number of new cases
- Vaccination coverage remains inconsistent across the region



# **Employer Vaccine Mandates**

 EEOC and CDFEH issued guidance that employers may require employees to be vaccinated with exemptions for medical and religious reasons

 Federal, state and some local governments have implemented vaccine and testing requirements for employees



### **Federal Level**

### Federal government

 Employees of the federal government and <u>onsite</u> contractors are required to show proof of vaccination or submit to regular testing

#### **Amtrak**

 All employees must show proof of vaccination by November 1 or submit to weekly testing; Amtrak is developing policy for onsite contractors



# **Local Transit Agencies**

#### **BART**

- BART employees must show proof of vaccination or continue to wear masks at all times while on District property
- Employees who show proof of vaccination receive two days of paid time off



### **JPB Member Counties**

#### **CCSF**

 Policy requires that city employees must be fully vaccinated no later than 10 weeks after the FDA gives final approval to at least one COVID-19 vaccine, including SFMTA

#### Santa Clara County

- Policy requires employees to be vaccinated by September 30 unless they have requested an exemption.
- County contractors may be banned from county worksites and barred from supplying services to the County if they fail to comply

#### San Mateo County

Currently does not have a policy requiring vaccination for county or transit employees

### JPB Safety and Vaccination Efforts

- Mask mandate to protect riders, public safety officers, and TASI employees.
- In April and May 2021, JPB and TASI sponsored events to promote vaccination
  - Hundreds of SamTrans and TASI employees were vaccinated at vaccine clinics held at Diridon Station and North Base
  - SamTrans offered incentives including paid time off for employees who submitted proof of vaccination
  - TASI offered employees up to 4 hours of pay for submitting proof of vaccination through June 2021 and recently reinstated this incentive program



### Future Safety and Vaccination Efforts

#### SamTrans

 JPB is working with SamTrans to implement a policy requiring employees and contractors that work in SamTrans facilities to submit proof of vaccination or submit to regular testing in the next few weeks

#### **TASI**

- JPB is working with TASI to implement vaccination/testing policy that would cover TASI employees working at Caltrain/SamTrans facilities
- Currently, 65% of TASI's employees are vaccinated, including 73% of conductors



# JPB Contractors (excluding TASI)

- JPB contractors' policies on COVID-19 vaccination requirements vary
- Staff surveyed contractors based at Caltrain facilities and working on capital projects.
  - Only 7 out of 26 of these contractors have vaccination policies requiring proof of vaccination or regular testing
  - For contractors who reported vaccination rates, the rates of employees vaccinated ranged from 43 to 100 percent
- JPB is working with its contractors to encourage them to implement vaccination/testing policies
