



CURRENT STATUS

- No mask mandates at federal, state, or local levels
- Most Bay Area transit agencies, including Caltrain, SFMTA, SamTrans, and VTA, are strongly recommending, but not requiring, that passengers wear masks
- BART has express statutory authority to issue citations for violations of BART safety protocols
- Caltrain requires that its conductors wear masks; 43.7% of passengers currently wearing masks based on recent survey

JPB'S AUTHORITY

 JPB may issue safety protocols including a requirement to wear masks on trains but does not have authority to enforce a mandate through the issuance of citations or other penalties

 Issuance of citations is limited to certain proscribed conduct, such as fare evasion, smoking, and unruly behavior



OPTIONS

- Continue to follow state/county guidance and strongly recommend that passengers wear masks without imposing a mask mandate
- 2. Impose a mask mandate but without the power to enforce the requirement through the issuance of citations
- 3. Work with the Legislature and other transit agencies to expand the authority of transit agencies to issue citations to include health and safety protocols issued by the transit agency

RECOMMENDATION

- Continue to strongly recommend that passengers wear masks
- Authorize staff to work with other transit agencies and the Legislature to expand enforcement authority to include health and safety protocols
