Items Recommended for Board Action

- Update 3 critical consulting contracts to increase funding and align support with the PCEP schedule.
- All 3 items unanimously approved by the Change Management Board (CMB) and recommended for approval by the JPB Finance Committee.
- All 3 projects funded through current funds within the approved \$2.44B CalMod program budget.
- Increased contract totals will not obligate the JPB to purchase any specific level of service as work directives are negotiated and issued as-needed.

Traction Power SCADA Change Order and Contract Time Extension

Recommendation: Approve an increase to the existing \$4.5M contract authority for Wabtec Railway Electronics, Inc. ("Wabtec"), in an amount not to exceed \$1,036,122 for completion of Traction Power SCADA System.

Change Order Provides For:

- Additional technical support between the completion of the Site Acceptance Test and the start of revenue service, including anticipated future points and screen display changes
- 1,000-hour availability test to be performed upon commencement of electrified service
- Full integration of Traction Power Office SCADA which will be ongoing through system acceptance in 2024



B&G CalMod Safety and Security Contract Capacity Increase & Extension

- Recommendation: Approve an increase to the original \$5.1M contract with B&G Transportation Group, LLC ("B&G"), in an amount not to exceed \$4,432,182 for ongoing PCEP safety and security support through project closeout.
- Increased Contract Capacity Allows For:
 - Additional FTE added after March 10th incident
 - Additional field safety coverage for night shifts and additional coverage to support developing project needs as required during testing phases
 - Special safety task forces to address incidents, safety standdown training
 - Additional support related to hazard management program, safety and security plan preparation, safety certification and training, and emergency response training tasks
 - Contract extension from December 2023 through December 2024



AECOM Program Management Support Contract Capacity Increase & Extension

- Recommendation: Approve an increase to the current AECOM approved contract authority of \$36.4M, in an amount not to exceed \$11,943,960 to ensure uninterrupted program management support services for CalMod.
- Increased Contract Capacity Allows For:
 - A dedicated Program Management Director to manage all PM functions
 - Ability to hire additional schedulers, cost analysts, and contract administrators
 - Ability to hire additional document controls specialist and document control lead
 - Ability to hire field quality assurance representative
 - Contract extension from February 2023 through December 2024
