
What Caltrain Offers

- Bike Parking
 - Racks
 - Lockers
 - Shared Access Bicycle Parking
- Bikes Onboard Caltrain
 - Two bike cars on trains
 - 40 per gallery car (total of 80)
 - 24 per Bombardier (total of 48)

Bicycle Boardings: Top 5 Stations

| Station | 2011 AWBR | 2012 AWBR | % Change |
|------------------|--------------|--------------|-------------|
| San Francisco | 895 | 1,051 | 17.5% |
| Palo Alto | 430 | 520 | 20.9% |
| Mountain View | 320 | 374 | 17.0% |
| Redwood City | 217 | 263 | 21.1% |
| San Jose Diridon | 229 | 248 | 8.3% |
