



- All Sheriff's Office property rooms are now on the 529 property room system.




# Current Environment- By the Numbers 2020




Total Number of Reported Bike Thefts: 26

65% of Caltrain passengers report bike thefts online.




Bike theft crimes make up less than 1% of total report crimes reported within the Transit Bureau.




# Operation Bike Recovery: Bait Bike




