Project Goals

- In coordination with the City of Palo Alto, project will improve safety at the Churchill Ave grade crossing for
 - Motorists
 - Pedestrians
 - Trains
- Project will improve flow of a large volume of pedestrian and bicycle traffic due to the proximity to the adjacent school



Scope of Work

- Widening of the northern pedestrian crosswalk by installing track panels and concrete ties
- Install new guard rails, crossing gate arms & flashers, pedestrian sidewalk gates to maintain channelizing through the widened crosswalk
- Install pavement markers and markings and signage to clearly identify railroad crossing
- Improved signal preemption





Scope of Work

 City of Palo Alto will perform work to modify the traffic signals, replace sidewalk, pavement markers and signage

Lowest Responsive and Responsible Bidder

- VNH was the **sole bidder** for the project
- Staff, in consultation with legal counsel, has found the single bid received from VNH in response to the IFB to be nonresponsive
 - Failed to submit Bidder's Bond to the JPB within two business days after the bid opening,
 - Failed to meet the minimum experience requirement, as stated in the IFB documents.
- VNH bid did not provide evidence of experience in trackwork.
- Staff met with VNH to request additional evidence of qualifications. VNH did not supply the requested information.
