## Caltrain State and Federal Legislative Update

## Federal

- Rail Safety Act (S. 576)
  - Would place new regulations on rail operators with hazardous substances on their lines
  - Passed Senate Commerce Committee
- Federal Community Project Requests
  - Congressman Mullin and Congresswoman Eshoo included Caltrain's Grade Crossing Improvements Project (Request: \$2.8M)
  - Project encompasses important safety improvements at six crossings
- Federal-State Partnership for Intercity Passenger Rail Grant Program
  - Caltrain applied for Diridon Station, partnering with other DISC members SJDOT and VTA with letters of support from MTC and CHSRA



## State

- State Budget
  - Budget bills passed June 27 include \$5.1B for transit
  - Restores previously allocated \$2B for TIRCP
  - Includes \$1.1B for Zero-Emission Transit Capital Program with flexibility for use in addressing operating and ZE capital needs
  - Funds would be distributed via formula (MTC would likely receive 36.5%)
  - Includes accountability measures
  - BEMU funding pot is preserved
    - Caltrain has been working with CalSTA and Caltrans to secure funding since 2022 with agreement expected in the coming weeks on a battery-equipped electric multiple unit (BEMU) for the Gilroy service area
    - Caltrain needs the commitment of funding before August 15 to exercise the Stadler option
