Project Highlights

- Schedule: No change to revenue service date fall 2024
- Budget: No change to project budget \$2.44B
 - \$0.83M draw from \$50M Shared Risk Pool in June 2023
 - No draw from \$40M Project Contingency in June 2023
- Construction
 - Sixteen weekend shutdowns complete
 - Weekly overhead contact system projections continue to improve
 - Live run testing started on Caltrain property
 - First public train tour on July 29th
- Electric Trains
 - Next two trainset expected Fall 2023



Safety and Security

Time Period	Reportable Injury Rate

Phase 7 — San Francisco to Millbrae


Weekends: August 12-13, 19-20, 26-27

- Service ends early on weekends




Temporary Weekday Service Changes


- Temporary Weekday Changes: August 7-25
 - Reduction from 104 trains to 90 trains per day
 - Peak hour service reduced to 3 trains per hour per direction
 - Baby Bullet service suspended
 - Span of service remains the same
- Minimal impact on midday and evening service
- Single-tracking between 4th & King and 22nd St. affecting boarding platform
- Supports final signal installation and testing cutover


