



# Major Rail Projects – 4<sup>th</sup> and King Area



### 4KY Project Scope: Package A and B

#### Package A - Site Clearing


Early site clearing of Caltrain assets to allow DTX to begin underground construction of the 4th and Townsend St. Station as early as 2026.

## Package B – Track and Systems

Track and systems work to provide for the twotrack mainline connection to the DTX U-Wall in 2029.








### Memorandum of Agreement (MOA)

- In March 2023, the Caltrain Board approved the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA)
- The MOA authorized reimbursement from TJPA to Caltrain for oversight of the 30% design work for the 4th and King Yard Preparation work
- Caltrain has retained consultant services for this project manager oversight role
- The Caltrain consultant works directly with the TJPA engineering consultant team to ensure the design is consistent with Caltrain's design requirements



# **Anticipated Timeline of Agreements**





<u>Caltrain Board item</u>: Recommendation for delivery method for 4KY Package B: Track and Systems



The MOA amendment will add \$460,000 to:

- Provide additional oversight and design review since the completion of 30% design is pushed back to early 2024 from the September 2023 estimate in the MOA
- Support development of the 4th and King Yard Preparation agreement
- Provide additional support to advance the project and seek agreement on delivery method and lead(s)



## Recommendation and Next Steps

Staff recommend that the Board:

- Authorize the Executive Director to execute an amendment to the MOA with TJPA for an additional \$460,000 of reimbursable Caltrain expenses
- Amend the FY24 Capital Budget to include the additional \$460,000 in reimbursable expenses from the MOA amendment

TJPA plans to bring the amendment to their October Board meeting for approval
