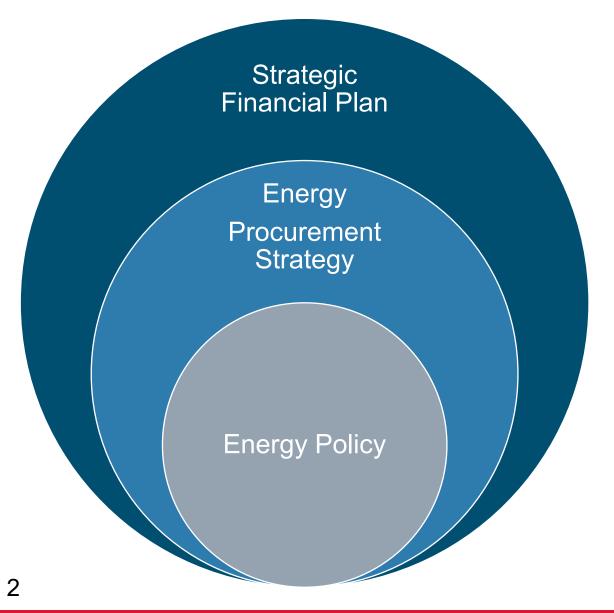

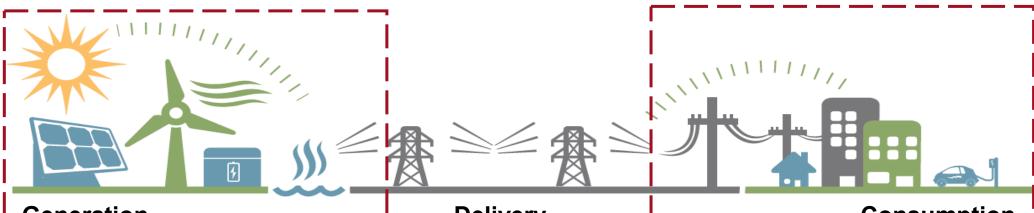
# Why Adopt an Energy Policy?



- BB&A is developing Caltrain's Strategic Financial Plan, which includes an Energy Procurement Strategy (EPS)
- The EPS is aimed to minimizing the risk and cost of energy procurement
- The Energy Policy supports the EPS by documenting and formalizing Caltrain's approach to energy procurement



## What will the Energy Policy Address?



#### **Generation** CCA Providers or PG&E

#### Questions such as:

What type of electricity should we procure? What vendor should we procure from? Should we and can we self-generate electricity? Should we pursue wholesale market access? What are the environmental, cost and

operational implications of these decisions?

Delivery PG&E Consumption Caltrain

#### Questions such as:

Should we install energy storage? Should we install renewable energy? Should we and can we participate in demand management? Should we prioritize energy efficiency? What are the environmental, cost and operational implications of these decisions?
