Environmental Clearance and Approvals

- California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA)
- JPB adopted a Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) for the project and filed a Notice of Determination (NOD) in February 2021.
- JPB received permits from Regional, State, and Federal resource agencies for the Project.
- Construction of the Project commenced in 2023. Major construction was paused after 2023 to incorporate Project modifications.
- The "Modified Project" requires consideration under CEQA.



CEQA Addendum

- JPB prepared a CEQA addendum to evaluate the proposed changes in the Modified Project.
 - Refinements to the Habitat Mitigation and Monitoring Plan (HMMP).
 - Project construction activities, sequence and duration, temporary shoring, and construction limits.
 - Limited nightwork activities.
 - Potential use of impact hammer.
- The Modified Project contains only minor technical changes or additions and none of the conditions described in CEQA Guidelines Section 15162 are present, therefore an Addendum is the appropriate document.
- No significant impacts or substantial increase the severity of impacts previously identified in the MND



Project Update

- JPB staff incorporated resource agency feedback into revised permit applications.
- Project submitted revised permit applications to the agencies on February 6, 2025
 - CWA Section 401 Regional Water Quality Control Board
 - CWA Section 404 US Army Corps of Engineers
 - Streambed Alteration Agreement California Department of Fish and Wildlife
 - Encroachment Permit Santa Clara Valley Water District
- Additional JPB coordination, including multi-agency review meeting on February 25, 2025
- CDFW, RWQCB, and Valley Water are responsible agencies under CEQA.



Next Steps

- Requesting adoption of the Modified Project CEQA addendum for administrative record
- File Notice of Determination (NOD) with the Santa Clara County Clerk and State Clearinghouse
- Staff will provide the MND and Addendum to CEQA responsible agencies for their use to issue modified permits
- Staff will seek from this committee, and the JPB Board, a subsequent approval for the Modified Project at a future meeting
- Return to Board in Spring 2025 with Modified Project to seek budget approval and amend construction contract and Change Order authority with Walsh Construction Company
