Purpose and Recommended Action

Staff will present updates on Caltrain's proposed Fiscal Year (FY) 2026 Operating Budget and FY2026-FY2027 Two-Year Capital Budget, FY2027 Operating Budget development process, 10-Year Strategic Financial Plan, discuss strategies to regain financial resiliency, and seek general Board guidance on what strategies and priorities to focus on to balance the FY2027 Operating Budget, secure more capital funding support from funding partners, and enhance Caltrain's long-term financial outlook.

Discussion

Over the last several months, staff has focused on balancing the FY2026 Operating Budget and identifying strategies to regain financial resiliency. Staff has also completed the development of the Draft FY2026-FY2027 Two-Year Capital Budget under the significant cost increase pressure from the Guadalupe Bridge Replacement Project. The workshop will allow Directors to receive updates on the budget efforts and various strategies Caltrain staff has been pursuing and to provide general guidance on what priorities and questions to focus on in preparation of the FY2027 Operating Budget and for addressing the long-term financial challenges with both our operations and capital programs.
