Background

In 2020, the Peninsula Corridor Joint Powers Board (JPB)
entered a contract with The San Mateo County Sheriff's Office
to provide Law Enforcement services.

Provides:

- Patrol services within the JPB's service area,
- Coordination of all requests for police service,
- Collision investigations,
- Police reports & K9 units,
- Crime scene investigation and criminal forensics,
- Coroner's services,
- Coverage for special events and backup personnel



Budget Impact

- Staff is seeking to amend the current contract with the San Mateo County Sheriff's Office to exercise the option to extend the contract term by 5 years, through June 30, 2030, ensuring continued and uninterrupted Law Enforcement service to the JPB.
- Funds for the requested contract extension are included in the JPB's included in current and future year operating budgets.



Proposed Motion

- Authorizes the Executive Director, or designee, to execute an amendment Contract Number 2020-22, Law Enforcement Services, to extend the contract by 5 years at an estimated cost of \$41,076,586, in a form acceptable to Legal Counsel.
- 2. Authorize the Executive Director or designee to execute the contract amendment, and any related documents necessary to implement the terms of the contract, as amended, in a form approved by legal counsel.
