# Caltrain FIFA/Super Bowl Objectives

- Provide Reliable, Safe and Secure Transportation to Games/Events
- Leave Positive Impression for All Riders, including International Attendees
- Spend Funds/Staff Time on Efforts that Improves Ridership Experience for All
- Improve Accessibility, including Multilingual Access

# Major Event Dates

## **February 2026 – Super Bowl LX**

- February 2: Opening Night in San Jose
- February 4-7: Super Bowl Experience at Moscone in San Francisco
- February 8: Super Bowl LX at Levi's Stadium

## **June-July 2026: FIFA World Cup**

- June 13-July 1: 6 Matches at Levi's Stadium
- June 11-14: FanFest at Mission Rock San Francisco
- Other Watch Parties throughout the Bay Area

# Event Venue Locations and Capacities

- Levi's Stadium – 60,000
- Moscone Center – ~ 20k capacity
- SAP – 18,500
- Mission Rock – 10,000



# 2016 Super Bowl Service and Ridership

## **Service**

- Weekend hourly service
- 3 pre-game & 3 post-game special scheduled trains

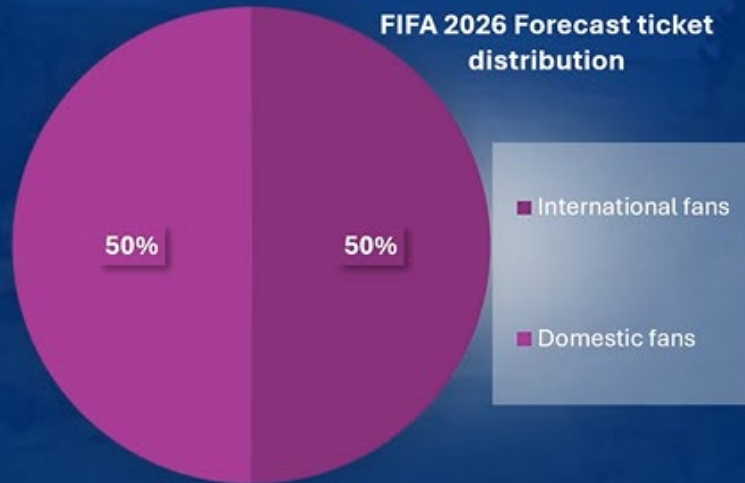
## **Ridership**

- 4,000 riders through Mountain View Station pre-game between 9:30a-1:30p
- 4,500 riders through Mountain View Station post-game between 7:30p-9:30p
  - 1,300 riders on busiest train (Special train at 8:30p; game ended at 7:00p)

**Current available hourly capacity on weekends is around 2,000**

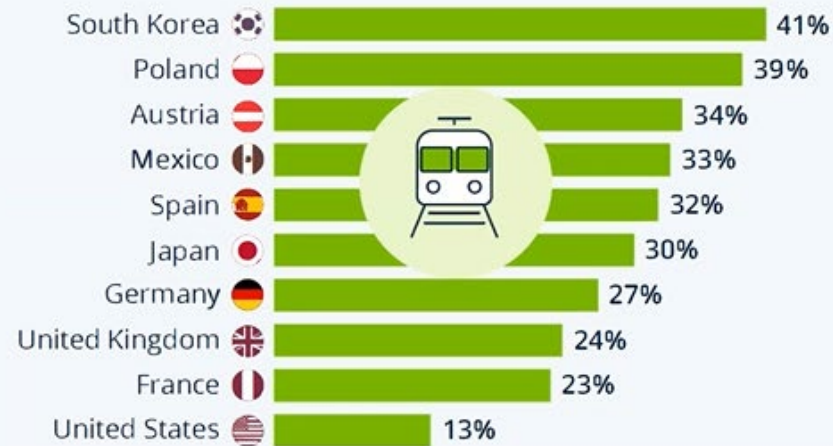
## Soccer fans: travel behavior implications

# Operations Plan

- Coordination with VTA, Transit PD, Mountain View City on Mountain View Station logistics
- Pre and post-game field call trains planned as needed for capacity
- Contingency planning with bus operations
- Coordination with BART, SFMTA, SamTrans for transfers at other key stations (Millbrae, San Francisco, San Jose)
- Station cleaning/repairs prior to event day

# Safety/Security

- Increased staffing and patrols throughout system
- Coordination with local partners on security planning and enforcement
- Deployment of K9 units and drones
- Mobile Command Center at Mountain View Station
- TSA Tabletop Exercise Postponed

# Communications

- Wayfinding & Ambassadors at Key Stations
- Media/News Releases
- Social and Web Presence
- Station/Train Activations
- Onboard Announcements
- Partnerships to Cross-promote Events

# Fares/Parking

- Clipper 2.0 (credit card payments) ready by end of 2025
- Coordination with VTA around Token Transit “Show and Go Pass”
  - For Super Bowl Sunday, only customers holding a special VTA light rail ticket will be allowed to board Levi’s Stadium bound trains
- Parking Surcharge being considered at Mountain View Station
