Proposed Actions

- Award a contract to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, CR Fence Company Inc. of Fortuna, California (CR Fence), for a total amount of \$1,738,400 for the Right of Way Fencing Project.
- Authorize Executive Director or designee to execute contracts with CR Fence in full conformity with the terms and conditions of the solicitation documents, and in forms approved by legal counsel.

Background

- Fencing needs within the right of way continue to change as conditions at adjacent sites evolve.
- Currently: ~20% of right of way unfenced.
- Protect district assets.
- Secure the right of way.
- Reduce liability.



Contract Goal

- To provide the JPB with a qualified contractor to continue and expand implementation of the fencing, which had been successfully installed along the JPB Right of Way (ROW) under previous 2016 and 2023 contracts.
- Two-year contract to continue installing various types of fencing, including vandal-resistant fencing, at key locations along the JPB ROW.
- Will help to deter trespassing, illegal dumping and encampments.

Project Scope

Installation of right of way fencing on Caltrain right of way in several locations from San Francisco to San Jose.

The scope of work includes

- Site clearing
- Fence demolition
- Welded wire mesh or expanded metal
- Human gates and Vehicles gates

Solicitation Process

- On January 9, 2026, the JPB issued Invitation for Bids (IFB) 25-J-C-054 for Right of Way Fencing Project.
- The RFP was advertised on the JPB's eProcurement website.
- The JPB established a 20% SBE utilization goal for the Project.
- In response to the IFB, the JPB received three responsive bids.
- CR Fence is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

Budget Impact

- Staff conducted a price analysis and determine CR Fence's prices are fair and reasonable.
- The Project Budget has sufficient funding to support this proposed contract.

Proposed Actions

- Award a contract to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, CR Fence Company Inc. of Fortuna, California (CR Fence), for a total amount of \$1,738,400 for the Right of Way Fencing Project.
