Quiet Zone at Palo Alto Ave Crossing

City of Palo Alto-Led Project

This project will install safety improvements, including a median island, bicycle striping, and extension of the protected left-turn lane.

Project Status: Construction

Anticipated Completion: Fall 2026

Embarcadero Rd Improvements Phase 1

City of Palo Alto-Led Project

This project will add bicycle, pedestrian, landscaping, and traffic-calming improvements along Embarcadero Rd between Alma St and Emerson St. Later phases will focus on Embarcadero Rd between Alma St and El Camino Real.

Project Status: Phase 1 Construction

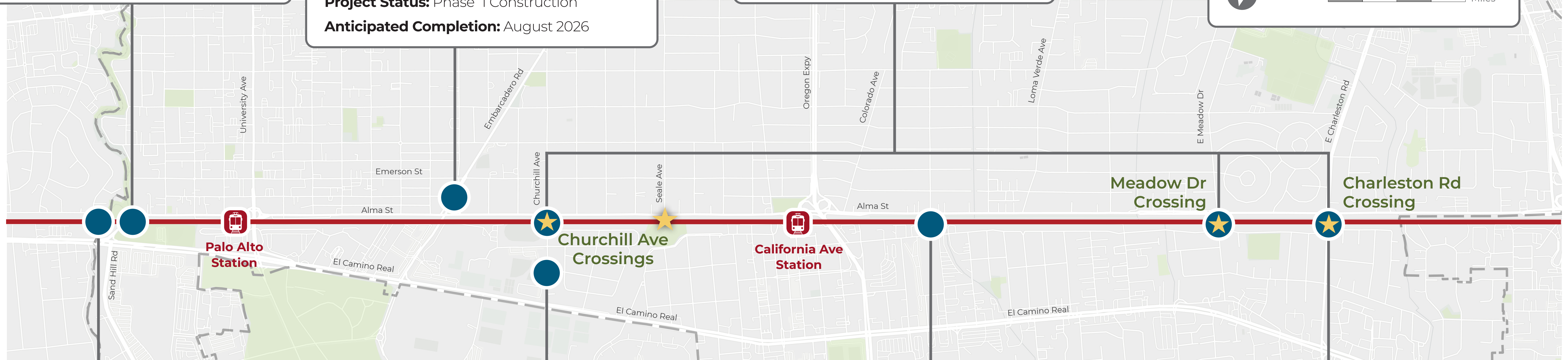
This project will install near-term safety improvements at each rail crossing, including Four-Quadrant Gate Systems

San Francisquito Creek Bank Permanent Stabilization Project

Caltrain-Led Project

This project will permanently stabilize the San Francisquito Creek embankment to protect critical rail and bicycle/pedestrian infrastructure from erosion and future storm impacts.

Project Status: Construction

Anticipated Completion: February 2027

Churchill Ave Enhanced Bikeway Project

City of Palo Alto-Led Project

This project will connect the Stanford Perimeter Trail with the Castilleja-Park-Wilkie bicycle boulevards, Palo Alto High School, and the Embarcadero Bike Path.

Project Status: Construction

Anticipated Completion: Early 2027

South Palo Bicycle and Pedestrian Connectivity Project

City of Palo Alto-Led Project

This project is evaluating alternatives for a new grade-separated bicycle and pedestrian rail crossing near El Dorado Ave.
