

Groundbreaking Press Conference



Electric Train Design Outreach

Construction Update

On July 13, Caltrain held a community meeting regarding upcoming work for San Bruno and South San Francisco. Caltrain will mail construction notices to residents adjacent to the railroad right-of-way, and will hold community meetings prior to construction activities in each work area (see map).

City councils, supervisors, and local, state and federal elected officials who represent the area where construction activities will take place will be notified prior to construction.

City Design Review Meetings

Caltrain is continuing to meet with cities where 65% OCS pole design is complete. Currently, this includes cities in the northern ends of Segments 2 and 4 (see map).
